## Climate

**Proper Clothing.** You will enjoy warm days and cool nights. Please be aware that most Breckenridge properties do not provide air conditioning due to the mild Summer climate. Open the windows and let the fresh, cool mountain air in. Another benefit of Breckenridge's high elevation and lack of humidity is our scarcity of bugs and mosquitoes. Feel free to leave the sticky bug spray at home. It is best to dress in layers and be prepared for sudden weather changes. Breckenridge is a casual mountain town, you can leave the high heels at home and be comfortable in jeans and a light jacket.

**Sun & Sunburn.** Breckenridge sits at 9600 feet and the sun is 40% stronger. It is best to protect your skin with the appropriate sun screen. Lip balm and sunglasses are highly recommended.

**Altitude Sickness.** If you are visiting from a lower elevation, you might experience some sort of altitude sickness. Symptoms include fatigue, headache, sleep disturbance and nausea. Stay properly hydrated, avoid tobacco and alcohol. Rest is the key to treating many forms of altitude sickness!



## Your Rental Unit

**Telephone.** Not all units managed by Ski Country Resorts are equipped with a land line phone. Please remember to bring your cell phone if you will need to make or receive any calls.

## Summer Road Construction

**State Highway 9 - Frisco to Breckenridge.** Summer of 2015 work includes median work cleanup and four lane project finalization. Motorists can expect minimal traffic impacts, with daily single lane closures both northbound and southbound. Working hours are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Speed limits are reduced to 45 mph through the construction zone.

**Eastbound I70.** Part of a comprehensive plan to improve travel in the I-70 Mountain Corridor includes a 13-mile upgrade to create the 'Mountain Express Lane', a wide shoulder that – only during peak travel periods – will operate as a third travel lane. There continue to be single lane closures in various locations along the corridor in both the eastbound and westbound directions. Lane closures typically occur between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays and 6 a.m. and noon on Fridays. Expect delays during this time.
